**12:00 Parade riders must pre-register** you can call ahead 252-426-7567 or visit one of the campsites show coggins at Winfall check in. You need to be at staging area **by noon** to wait for the train arrival you need to be ready to pull out with the wagon train and **plan to ride to Newbold campsite**, you can shuttle back to staging to get your rigs **after parade is over**.

**1:00 PM-2:00PM** Train arrives at the Winfall Municipal Center and Park. Rest and water animals. Restrooms available. Train will assemble at staging area for parade. Train needs to stay close together from this point on. We will be crossing the historic "S" bridge into Hertford. **For your safety and as a courtesy to officers helping with traffic, keep moving at an even pace. Keep safe distance between wagons but no large gaps.**

**2:30 PM** Wagon train departs Winfall for Hertford's parade by 3pm.  
*If you **don't want to ride in the parade** you can drive your support vehicle to our staging area in Winfall instead of the Newbold site. **You** will need to notify shuttle driver to pick you up and take you back to the Belvidere campsite.*

**4:30 PM** Train arrives back at Newbold Campsite.

**4:30 PM-5:00PM** Afternoon shuttle back to Newbold site.
